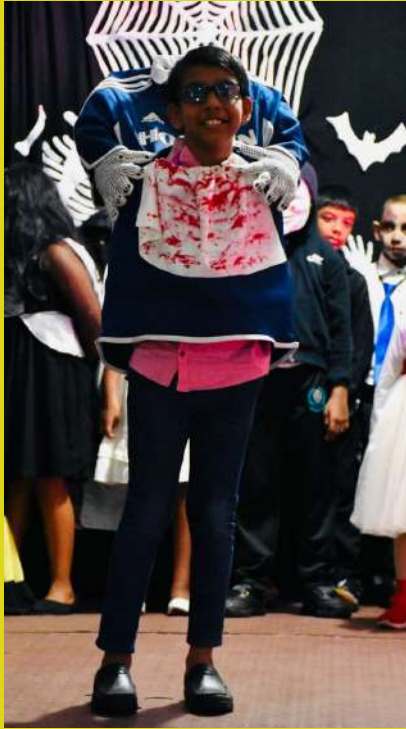
Halloween Magic Unleashed at Leeds Panadura!

Fruits of Fun: Hands-On Learning at Leeds Homagama

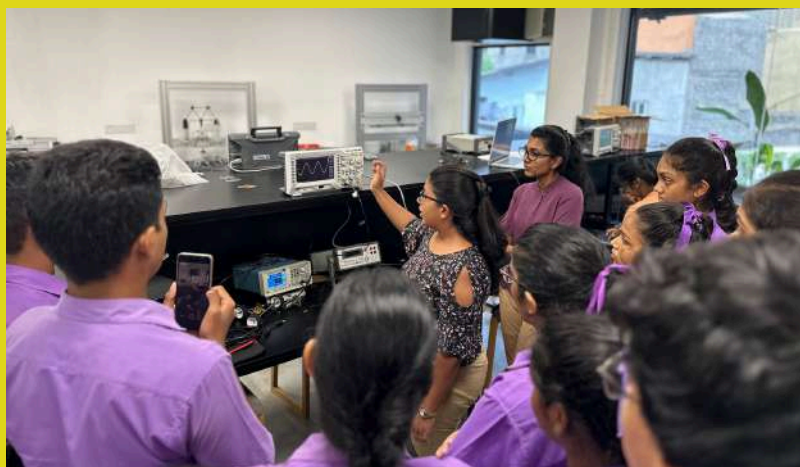
